### ATTENTION OWNERS/EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN REGISTERED DOGS

If you are the owner/exhibitor of a dog registered with a foreign registry (not yet dual registered with AKC) please review the eligibility requirements in The Rules Applying to Dog Shows, chapter 11 section 1.

Most important to note are the following:

1. Dogs must be individually registered with the American Kennel Club by the day of the event to be eligible for exhibit in the Bred by Exhibitor class.
2. Dogs are eligible to compete in AKC events using the foreign registration for a period of 30 days. That 30-day period begins with the date of first exhibit, *regardless of whether the dog earned any points or awards*. To continue to compete in AKC events beyond the initial 30-day period the dog must be either individually AKC registered or by the date of the event have been granted an extension to exhibit using the foreign registration. ## Overnight & Reserved Day Parking

Self-contained RVs and trailers will be allowed to setup overnight on the show site in designated areas starting at **3:00 P.M. on Wednesday**. All parking will be on a first come, first served basis (see pre-registration form in this premium list) and there will be NO saving of spaces the day of the show. All parking will be under the direction of the overnight parking attendant and the event committee. There are no special accommodations for handicap RV parking. Generators must be turned off between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M. Overnight security will be on duty. Most spaces are approximately 30' wide x 40' deep and you must fit in the space you are assigned. This includes slides, ex-pens, tow vehicles and additional vehicles. If you use chips or paper in your ex-pens, please clean up the area prior to leaving the show.

**ELECTRIC AND WATER HOOKUPS:** Those requesting electric will be assigned in order of receipt of pre-registration, with preferences given to those staying all five days. A daily parking fee of **\$50.00** per day will be collected for sites with 15 amp electric. There will be access to potable water (but no hookups to water). There is a dump station on the Fairgrounds but sites do not have individual sewer hookups. There is to be NO dumping of grey or black water at any time on the grounds.

**PREMIUM DAY PARKING:** There are a limited number of premium parking spaces available (with or without electric) available for those exhibitors planning to leave equipment (canopy tent, ex-pens, etc.) setup overnight and expecting to return to the same space each day. These spaces will be assigned in order of receipt of pre-registration (use the pre-registration form in this premium list). A Day Parking fee of **\$15.00** per day will be collected. 15 amp electric hookups are an additional fee of **\$15.00**. Setup will be directed by the event committee and the overnight parking attendant. Leaving equipment overnight in areas not designated for this purpose will not be allowed, and may be removed by the event committee.

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
